Student Tools will be accessible across all LMS platforms beginning July 1, 2025.

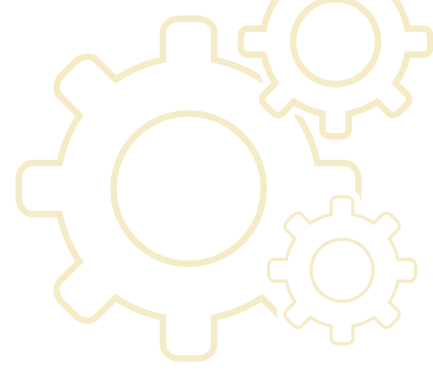
Please note that the availability of specific tools may vary depending on the course and lesson.

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Video

Key concepts have an alternative video presentation that delivers the same content in a different way. Showing videos as alternative instruction delivery caters to diverse learning styles, enhances engagement, and promotes deeper understanding.

Text

All pages may be retold at a lower reading level. Text will automatically simplify the instruction making it easier to remember.

Guided Notes

Note taking guides prompt students to capture key concepts to be used for later review. Research shows that taking notes is one of the best ways to reinforce learning.

Flashcards

The process of creating Flashcards engages active recall, aids in memory retention and makes the learning process personalized and efficient.

Tutor

Open ended questioned questions may be asked of the virtual tutor, with results limited to content found within Accelerate Education 6-12 lesson contents.
